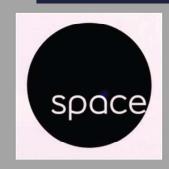




























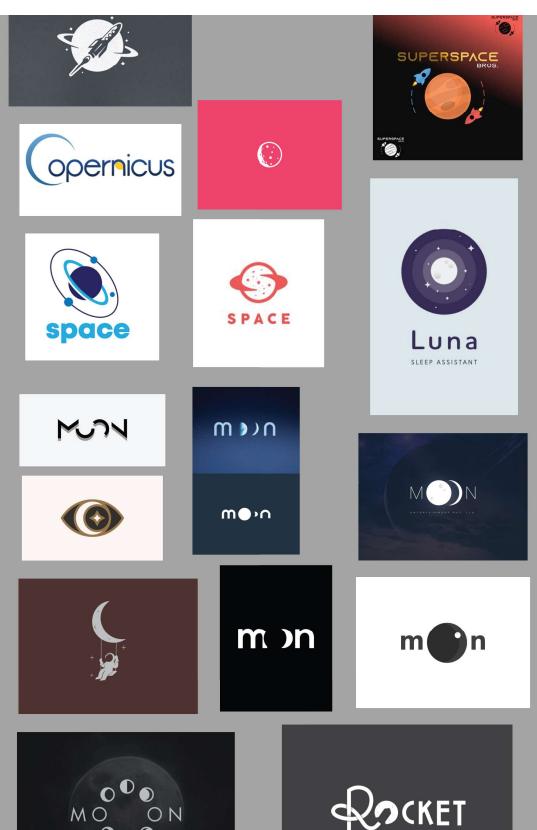

Big, blocky, strong fonts that you would see in a space station or spacecraft. Capture viewer's attention easily.

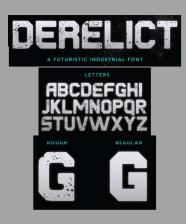


















FONTS (2)

Sci-fi-y fonts. A glow or shine. Or simply "strange" looking to evoke a sense mystery.















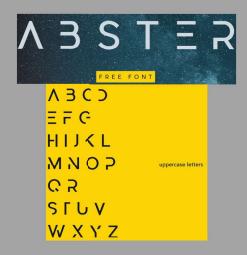
FONTS (3)

I tried to get a bit more of an organic feel to this. Took some inspiration from the "badge" kind of Logos



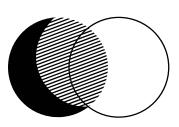

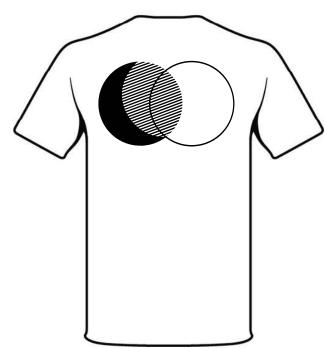

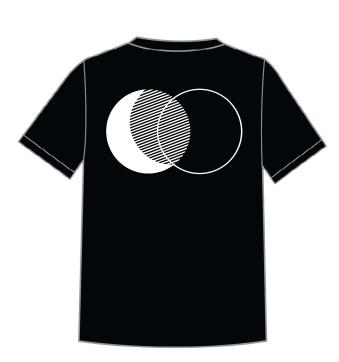












FINAL LOGO:

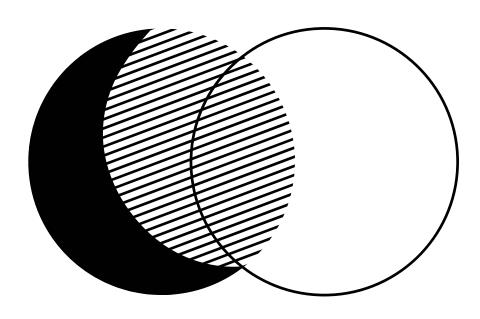


Picked this as the final as it has the most unique design. It is more distinct and easier to recognise from afar.
